

# PHASE 2

On July 27, 2001 Phase 2 of the Steel City Terrace Community Center renovation began and was completed on August 23, 2001. A total of 10 Steel City Student Residents performed 283.75 hours of service.



A total of 56 Student Residents, Keystone SMILES staff, AmeriCorps and VISTA members, and community volunteers performed 886.75 hours



21 Community youth performed 78 hours of service

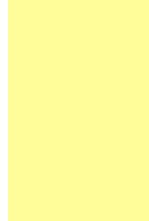
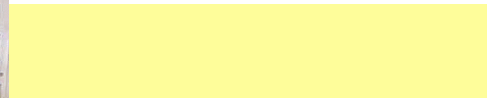

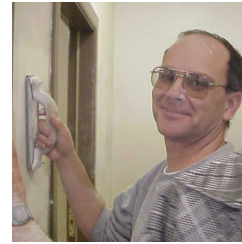

During the Steel City Terrace Project a total number of 46 staff, AmeriCorps members, community members, VISTA, and residents served on the Steel City Terrace site.

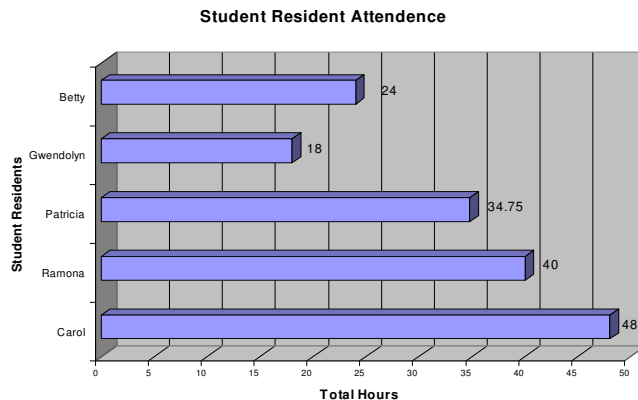

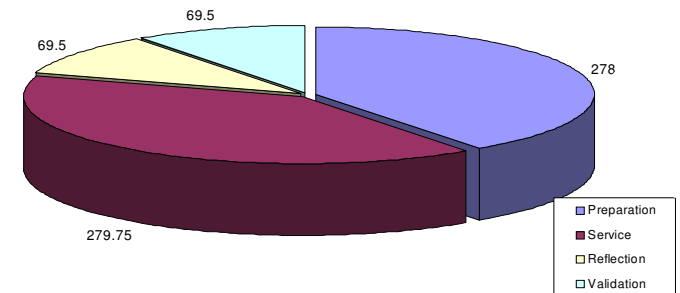
## STUDENT RESIDENTS

## SERVICE-LEARNING

### Total Service-Learning Hours



During the Steel City Terrace Project a total of 696.75 hours were performed. Of these hours 278 were in training preparation. Certainly while the participants were involved in the days service they continued to learn by doing. Preparation, in this case, refers to time spent exclusively on direct learning while 279.75 were in Service, 69.5 were used in Reflection, and 69.5 were in Validation.
