# Keystone SMILES AmeriCorps House of Trades

The House of Trades members have been very busy with various community service projects. We would like to share some of the projects they have been using their newly acquired or improved trade skills.



**Mercer County**

The House of Trades has partnered with Zion Education Center to remodel a house purchased by Zion Education Center to establish a new infant center, Gigi's House, identified as a need for families in the Farrell area.



**Clarion County**

The House of Trades recently completed a wheelchair ramp for a Vietnam Veteran who lives in Knox. The team constructed the ramp in their shop and assembled the end product at the couple's home. This will enable the couple to be able to leave their home with less effort.



## Food Bank - Venango/Clarion County

Every other month the House of Trades partners with Chapel on the Hill in Emlenton to help pack and distribute meals to families in need in the community. This month the food distribution served 173 people in 83 different families.

18 volunteers, staff and AmeriCorps members help to make this a successful event.

## Knox PKC and Private Preschool

Keystone SMILES PreK Counts and Private Preschool have 2 classrooms in which 32 children attend.

This month the children, staff and AmeriCorps members were able to take a field trip to Jones' Party Magic in Cranberry, PA, where they were able to jump and bounce on all of the inflatables in the facility. After being inside all winter this was a fun way to get out some extra energy.



## Sharpsville Gardens, Mercer County

Sharpsville Gardens Pre-K Counts has 1 classroom with 15 children. Keystone SMILES partnered with Mercer County Housing Authority 20 years ago to develop this program. The facility's programs are implemented with 3 staff along with 3 AmeriCorps members who also provide mentoring or STEM.

## Weed & Seed, Venango County



## STEM Training Presented by Riverview I U 6- Clarion County

AmeriCorps members from Knox PreK, Sharpsville Gardens PKC, and Weed & Seed recently participated in a STEM training provided by Riverview Intermediate Unit 6. This was a day spent learning different ways of teaching STEM to the students. Keystone SMILES education programs have been provided access to their STEM lending library. Participants were able to experiment with the different STEM learning modules from the library and then take them back to their sites to use with the children for academic support. It was a very informative and interactive learning day.
